Northeast Side Water Outage: Tanque Verde Road and Bear Canyon Road

(1500 hours) Tucson Water crews are responding to reports of a water outage in the northeast side of Tucson. A broken 12" water main is affecting an area in the vicinity of Tanque Verde Road and Bear Canyon Road. Water service as far south as Bears Path Road and as far north as Eagle Place may be affected by this main break.

Customers in this area are likely to experience extremely low water pressure at this time.

While the full extent of the area affected by the water line break is not known at this time, crews have located the affected pipe and are working to isolate the break so that they can initiate repairs and restore service back to normal. Once the break has been secured, a minimal number of customers along Tanque Verde Road are expected to be impacted until repairs are completed.

Motorists are asked to exercise caution while driving on Tanque Verde Road, between Bears Path and Bear Canyon Roads while crews work to repair the water line.
