

Planned Water Outage, Oracle/Magee, June 25th

A contractor for Tucson Water will need to shut down a water line to complete work on a project in the area of North Oracle and West Magee Road. Markham Contracting will be completing the installation of a Pressure Reducing Valve during the early Thursday morning hours on June 25th, between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. The work will result in a temporary outage of water service to approximately 400 customers in the area bounded by West Hardy Road to the north, North Northern Avenue to the east, West Chapala Drive to the south, and North La Canada Drive to the west.

Please see the attached map for exact boundaries of the scheduled water outage. Customers may notice air in their water pipes after service is restored. This can be addressed by running an outdoor faucet closest to the water meter for a short period of time until air trapped in the pipes is released.
