RESOLUTION NO. 21753

RELATING TO WATER; AMENDING THE TUCSON WATER SERVICE AREA POLICY BY AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 21602, ADOPTED AUGUST 4, 2010, SECTION 1.E. TO EXTEND THE VALID PERIOD OF WATER ASSURANCE LETTERS FROM ONE (1) YEAR TO TWO (2) YEARS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 1.E. of Resolution No. 21602 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Council adopt the following Tucson Water Service Area Policy:

E. If the requested water extension is approved, Tucson Water will issue a Water Assurance letter stating that Tucson Water will provide water service to the project based on the requested zoning of the subject parcels. The Assurance Letter, and any subsequent approval by Tucson Water, are valid for two years only, and will become null and void if the applicant does not take action to obtain water service in compliance with Tucson Water policies and procedures during that two-year period. If the two year time limit is reached, the Assurance Letter or any subsequent approval become null and void, and the applicant must submit a new application for water service extension.

SECTION 2. The various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this resolution.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Tucson that this resolution become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.




