### **Low-to-No Water System Pressure in Far Westside Area**

(1700 hours) Tucson Water is experiencing low-to-no system pressure in an area west of Silverbell Rd., north of Goret Rd., and south of El Camino del Cerro.

Tucson Water crews are currently working to restore service in the area as quickly as possible.

Bottled water will be made available at the entrance to Christopher Columbus Park, 4600 N. Silverbell Rd., by 6:30 p.m. if repairs are still in progress.

(update) Repairs to the water line were completed by 10:30 p.m. Over the next 90 minutes, water pressure built back up in the system. At midnight, Tucson Water put its boosters back into operation and customers in affected area had water service restored.
