- but emphasized his long residence, his contributions to the community, and his conservative use of water. Mr. LeCroy spoke as to the policy and the Board's ability to consider unique circumstances and recommend an exception to the policy. The develop-ability of the Town of Marana service area was discussed, as was the relative location to Tucson Water infrastructure. Mr. LeCroy stated that he hopes that his contributions and conservation measures can qualify him for an exception. Currently the parcel is served water from a functioning well; the connection to Tucson Water is desired to get the parcel off of well service. Appellant has not discussed water service or annexation with Marana at this time. The appellant stated that he believes the politics surrounding annexation in the parcel area make that a difficult prospect.
- c. **Call to the Audience** – Ms. Karilyn Roach addressed the Board regarding the denial of water service at the parcel in question and recommended the denial be upheld.
 - d. **WSARB Deliberation, and Recommendations or Decisions** – Member Mazzocco discussed and clarified the Water Service Area Policy parameters with Assistant City Attorney Chris Avery. The Appellant discussed under what circumstances policy exceptions might be made. Member Mazzocco motioned that the Tucson Water denial be upheld, with a recommendation that the Appellant approach the Town of Marana regarding annexation. Motion seconded by Acting Chair Elias. Motion passed unanimously by a voice-vote of 2-0.
