Plant this water-conserving native instead of a thirsty, grass lawn.

SACCUT

Use the low-flow kind to clean yourself.

WHOERS DAHE

This uses only about 1 1/2 gallons of water per flush instead of the standard 3 1/2 gallons.

OWL-OWLF OTTEIL

When using this, brush up with just one cup!

OHTTO SHRUB

Listen to this wise judge of water use.

TEEP

Turn off the faucet when washing these.

HISSED

Respect this desert native – a true conservation idol!

STEERD SOOITTE

Wash this only when you have a full load.
