Backstage Tips for the Successful Conservation Idol

Use It Over Again

- Use greywater from your washer, bathtubs, showers and bath sinks to irrigate your landscape.
- Most households generate 20-35 gallons per person per day.

Lose Your Leaks

- Put a new washer in the faucet to stop drips and save up to 50 gallons a day.
- Replace the faulty flapper on the toilet. A running toilet can waste up to 100 gallons of water a day.

Save the Rain

- A little soil can make the rain work for you. Build a berm or dig a shallow channel to direct rainwater to your plants. Also, a tree well helps keep water where the tree can use it.
- For those who choose, gutters, downspouts and cisterns can help store rainwater for use over a longer period of time.

Defeat the Drought

- With just a little effort, you can save gallons of water every day and make our community more drought resistant and sustainable.
