

A Tucson commercial office building reduced their water bills up to 75% with a payback period of less than 2 years!

What's Next?

1. Call Tucson Water to verify eligibility.
2. Contact City of Tucson, Planning and Development Services, Landscape Section at (520) 837-4947 or 837-4950 to approve your landscape design changes.
3. Tucson Water will send a Qualified Irrigation System Auditor to assess your irrigation system effectiveness before and after the changes have been made.
4. Upon completion, send the application form and items listed below to Tucson Water to process payment.

What Information Is Required?

- Labor / Materials receipts
- Copy of controller settings/irrigation schedule
- Sub-meter or separate Irrigation meter*
- Landscape water budget calculations (completed by Auditor)
- Approved City of Tucson, Planning and Development Services re-landscape plan

** Eligible applicants must provide an annual record of landscape water use for 5 years. This can be accomplished with a dedicated irrigation service meter or the installation of a private sub-meter.*

A local home owners' association invested in weather-based irrigation controllers for 5,000 homes. The sub-division reduced their water bill by nearly \$5,000 in 2-months.

Tucson Water will rebate qualifying irrigation system upgrades for 1/3 of materials and labor costs up to \$10,000 over a 2 year period.

Landscape irrigation can account for 26% of multi-family complex and 35% of commercial water use.

What Types Of Irrigation Improvements Are Covered?

- Irrigation system upgrade (spray or drip)
- Conversion from spray or bubbler to drip irrigation systems

What Costs Are Covered?

- Pre- & post-improvement audits –100% paid
- Labor & Services – Installation costs only
- Private irrigation sub-meter
- SWAT** approved controllers, and /or soil moisture sensors
- Central control systems
- Multi-stream rotor heads
- Rain sensors / shutoff controls
- Swing joints
- Master valves
- Check valves
- PVC pipe for drip systems
- Other pre-approved related items


