

How to make an appointment:

Day of appointment:

Please bring the following with you to your appointment: Your insurance card, your Dr's name and address, and the location of where you had your prior mammogram films.

Cost:

Insurance Coverage with **CIGNA, BlueCross BlueShield, United HealthCare, Medicare** and other select carriers. Non-Insured patients pay \$167.00 (includes the Radiologist Reading).

We will verify your insurance benefits and inform you if there are any charges that you will be responsible for.

Patients under the age of 30 must provide a Doctor's referral. Baseline mammograms recommended at age 35-39, (unless family history or symptomatic) and most insurance plans cover women every year over 40 years old.
